




The Essential Points





- You need your ID card and PIN code.
- You can't check out Journals.



When library is OPEN

▼Ookayama Library 1st floor and 1st basement floor






▼Suzukakedai Library near the library entrance



Returning books

Penalty for overdue

If you missed your returning due date, you can't check out or renew books for as many days as the book is overdue.

Monochrome 10 Yen / 1 sheet Color

50 Yen / 1 sheet

- There are some restrictions based on Copyright Act of Japan.
- Only library materials can be copied. (not your own materials)

Other services

Reserve

You can reserve a checked-out book.

Order

You can order books from the other campus.

ILL(Interlibrary Loan)

You can order materials from other libraries.

Renew

You can renew the due dates of books you have checked out.

- Commercial, non-educational, non-scholarly, or non-research use

- 1 You can search for e-journals using the e-journals and e-books list.
- 2 You can search for articles using databases by any keyword you like.
- (3) When using the electronic resources, you must comply with their terms of use.

Copyright Act of Japan

Copyright Act of Japan

Books, articles and other works are protected by the Copyright Act of Japan.

Do not copy these works without a proper authorization.

Copyright Act of Japan: Article 31 "Reproduction, etc. in libraries, etc."

Under certain exceptional conditions, you can copy without obtaining permission.

Copyright Act of Japan

Photocopying in libraries

- You can photocopy a part of a work (less than half)
- The purpose of photocopying must be for your own research or study.

Citing

Article 32 "Quotations"

Article 48 "Clear indication of source"

Don't treat results produced by others as your own work.

When citing them in your reports, you must:

- Distinguish them from your results
- Clearly indicate the sources
