



Library materials: books, journals, and more


Search Terms

Keywords: words in title, author, or other information of a material


What do you get by using Library Catalog?

- Order a book from another campus









In library use only: Books that can be used in the library, but cannot be checked out



3-1 If books are not on the shelf


Even if you identify the location of a book, you may not be able to find it on a bookshelf.


	Inter Library Loan (ILL)	Request
Charge	Borne by the library	No need
Days	About 1 week	Japanese books: about 1 to 2 months Non-Japanese books: may take more than 2 months
Notes	The time required depends on the requesting library.	The materials should be used by many students for learning purposes for a long period of time




















5-3 Attention to use of electronic resources

6. Copyright Act of Japan


6 Copyright Act of Japan

Books, articles and other works are protected by the Copyright Act of Japan.

Do not copy these works without a proper authorization.

Copyright Act of Japan: Article 31 "Reproduction, etc. in libraries, etc."

Under certain exceptional conditions, you can copy without obtaining permission.






